This is a <u>link</u> to a tragic story of a County Courthouse that **failed to test** their AED's for <u>six years</u>.

Our loaner inventory is composed of the most popular models that we find in our customers' facilities. Every effort is made to provide the same model to minimize the impact of familiarization before use.

Although there is a large inventory of loaner equipment, it is not unlimited. We will, on occasion, have to say, "I'm sorry, a loaner is not available."

Quite frankly, purchasing and maintaining all this loaner equipment isn't cheap. We simply ask two things, a nominal \$100.00 fee for use, and return it in the same condition in which it was received.
